2010 ARKANSAS PGA JUNIOR TOUR

ELIGIBILITY

Any junior residing in the State of Arkansas who is 9 years of age on or before May 14, 2010, but not older than 17 years of age as of July 31, 2010. Juniors will play in age group as per their age on July 31,

APPLICATIONS FOR ENTRY

Registration deadline: Thursday, May 27, 2010 at 5:00 pm. All entries must be filed on an official application. Incomplete applications or applications received after the entry deadline will not be accepted. Each event will have an instructional clinic prior to play. There is no fee for the clinics and they will be open to any junior in the State of Arkansas. All entrants must register and play in the region in which they live. Points will be awarded only to juniors playing in their own regions. All juniors will play in their designated age groups.

OFFICIATING

Arkansas PGA Professionals will be responsible for all clinics, events, and rules decisions. Play will be governed by the USGA Rules of Golf and all decisions made by the site professionals will be final. Any questions or inquiries should be directed to the Regional Directors or Barry Howard, Arkansas PGA Junior Tour Director.

The number of holes to be played (9 or 18) will be determined by the number of entries and the ages of the entrants. Age groups will be awarded plaques.

DRESS CODE

Boys' shirts must have collars and sleeves. Girls' shirts do not require collars or sleeves. No T-shirts, tank tops, open mesh or midriff tops. Boys' shirts must be tucked in at all times. Shorts must be of an appropriate length. No gym shorts or cutoffs. Caps must be worn with the bill facing forward. Soft spikes only - no metal spikes will be allowed. allowed.

ENTRY FEE

ENTRY FEE

The registration fee for each region of Arkansas Junior PGA Tour will be \$75.00. Entries must be sent to the Regional Director for the region in which the junior will play. All registration must be done on the attached form, however, due to the numbers involved, absolutely no changes or refunds will be made once the form is sent in. The \$75.00 registration fee enters juniors in all events for their region and includes an Arkansas PGA Junior Tour gift pack that will be distributed by the regional director at the events and a PGA Golf Passport. If a junior intends to play in an event, he or she must notify the host professional/club no later than 48 hours prior to the event. If a junior is unable to play in an event, it will be their responsibility to notify the host professional/club to withdraw their name from the competition.

Juniors that fail to notify the host professional/club are subject to removal from the Arkansas PGA Junior Tour.

PLADUES

Plaques will be awarded to the Winner and Runner-Up in each age division at each tournament in the region. Trophies will be given to the top finishers in each age division at the Arkansas PGA Junior Tour Overall Championship.

DATES AND STARTING TIMES

The dates of the events will vary from region to region. An 8:30 am shotgun start will be used at each event unless otherwise stated on the regional entry form.

GOLF CARS AND CADDIES

Juniors will not be allowed to use motorized golf carts or caddies. Parents and spectators are allowed to rent golf cars from the host facility or walk the golf course, but are confined to CART PATHS ONLY! Parents will not be allowed to have any contact with their junior or another junior at any time during the course of play. The junior must bring any rules questions to the attention of the host professional or regional director. Any violation of this policy will result in immediate disqualification of the junior from the event and the parent(s) will not be allowed on the golf course at any future Arkansas PGA Junior Tour events.

POINTS AND OVERALL CHAMPIONSHIP

PUINTS AND OVERALL CHAMPIONSHIP

10 points will be awarded to all participants that turn in completed and signed scorecards at each event. Those participants attending all events in their region earn 50 bonus points. Those attending all but one event in their region earn 25 bonus points. Juniors attending instructional clinics before play will be awarded 20 points per event. Top 10 finishers will receive points according to their finish at each event in their region:

Playoffs for Winner and Runner-Up plaques will be awarded points accordingly (100 and 90). All other points will be awarded according to finish. The top three (3) qualifiers in each age division in each region will qualify for the Arkansas PGA Junior Tour Overall Championship. At the Overall Championship, the qualifying juniors will be paired with Arkansas PGA Golf Professionals. Top finishers in the Overall Championship receive an invitation to the South Central Section PGA Junior Tournament of Champions to be held July 25th through July 30th.
